Local support

BaNES

- <u>Energy at Home</u> two energy related home improvement grant schemes for Bath and North East Somerset (BANES) residents on low income.
- <u>Citizen's Advice BaNES</u> offers free, confidential and impartial advice.
- Age UK BaNES offers cost of living support.
- Apply for Welfare Support | Bath and North East Somerset Council (bathnes.gov.uk) advice on how to apply for welfare support
- Share & Repair (Bath Library of Things) there are over 400 items that you can borrow to help with maintenance tasks.

Somerset/East Mendip

- Citizens Advice Mendip provides advice on on debt and money issues.
- Age UK Somerset offer help with claiming welfare benefits.
- <u>Somerset Village and Community Agent</u> who provide confidential, practical community-based solutions.
- <u>Somerset County Council's Household Support Fund</u> is designed to provide short-term urgent financial help for those on low incomes.



Wiltshire

- <u>Citizens Advice Wiltshire</u> offers free, confidential and impartial advice.
- Age UK Wiltshire provides a surviving winter grant for the elderly.
- <u>Cost of Living Support</u> gathers information through research carried out by <u>Wiltshire Citizens Advice</u>.
- Warm and Safe Wiltshire works in partnership with the Centre for Sustainable Energy to help residents live in safer and healthier homes across Wiltshire.
- Wiltshire Community Foundation Surviving Winter 2023/24 Campaign supporting elderly and vulnerable people to keep warm and safe.

Regional support

- 3SG offers <u>Cost of Living support and grants</u> for charities, councils and community groups to support people in fuel poverty, across South West.
- <u>Centre for Sustainable Energy</u> free energy advice training for anyone with three offers; 1. Training/advice/guidance to support people 2. Safe & Warm Support Groups 3. Referrals for people who need 1:1 help.
- <u>Too Good To Go</u> includes a lot of local pubs who have food offers (e.g. Toby Carvery offer £3/£4 'Magic Bags- a whole roast dinner to collect).

Warm spaces or hubs

- Warm welcome holds a directory of places for anyone in need of warmth, found in BaNES, Somerset and Wiltshire.
- <u>Frome Town Council</u> has a directory of warm spaces locally and a cost of living support leaflet.
- <u>Bath Abbey</u> Tuesdays from 12.30 to 2.30pm. 'The Cosy Place', in the Learning Room. There will be a free lunch of hot soup and a roll, fruit and hot drinks, as well as a range of activities and workshops. Abbey is also available Monday to Saturday as a 'warm place' to pray.



- <u>St Luke's Church Centre, Wellsway, Bath</u> Open house on Mondays from 11 am to 3 pm. Soup and roll lunch served, as well as tea and coffee. Come along for a chat, games and a children's corner.
- Malmesbury Library has a public living room where you can sit and have a cuppa, Tuesdays 1:30-4:30pm

National providers

- <u>StepChange</u> offers free, online debt advice and money guidance, with the widest range of debt solutions to help, no matter what you're dealing with.
- <u>Turn2us</u> has a directory of grants for individuals as well as a helpful Benefits Calculator so you can check if you are receiving all the benefits you are entitled to.
- <u>British Gas Energy Trust</u> grants available. You do not need to be a British Gas customer to qualify.
- <u>British Gas</u> and <u>Wales and West Utilities</u> have a priority register that offers support to vulnerable people who have accounts directly with them.
- Octopus Energy offer advice if you are struggling to pay energy bills.
- Wessex Water offers advice if struggling to pay water bill.
- <u>Bristol Water</u> offer advice on payments of water bill if you are in the Bristol area.
- NHS Low Income Scheme | NHSBSA for those on a low income to help pay for prescriptions, dental treatment, sight tests, glasses and contact lenses, cost of travelling for NHS treatment and NHS wigs and fabric supports.
- Household Support Fund (HSF) Government funding for those with low savings who may struggle with cost of living but not on the usual schemes covered in Winter Fuel Payments or Cost of Living payments.
